VI Homeowner Affidavit

VII Fee Clarification

Item #17, Mobile Home Unit Site:

When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites.

When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor.

When setting a HUD mobile home or a pre-manufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

General: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Bureau of Construction Codes. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector, providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted.
A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if
the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A
PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTES AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF
ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED. THE CHARGE TO RE-
OPEN A CLOSED PERMIT IS \$75.00
