### Personnel Policy & Procedures – Sick Leave Payout



In a response to the discussion about limiting the amount of payouts for departing employees at the October 17, 2019, City Manager Leven offered the following for consideration:

- A. Make the restriction only applicable to employees hired after September 2, 2019.
- B. Increase the restricted amount for all employees.
- C. Remove the restriction completely.

Motion by Commissioner Bryson, seconded by Commissioner Kellehan, to proceed with option A limiting the cap to employees hired on or after September 2, 2019. **Roll Call Vote.** Ayes: Vandenbossche, Bryson, Kellehan, Klaassen, Merchant, Vercammen. Nays: Hendrick. Motion Carried

#### KaBOOM Parklet Location

DPW Superintendent Itrich provided a preliminary site plan and breakdown of additional costs associated with moving the Bridge to Bay Musical Parklet behind the library. He estimated the additional costs to be \$8,150 for the new location. He stated that the relocation still needed to be approved by KaBOOM and, if approved, additional funding needed to be requested.

DPW Superintendent Itrich shared his concern over the ability to recruit volunteers for this volunteer-based project. He stated that there was no money in his budget for wages for building the parklet.

Commissioner Hendrick suggested putting out a request on Facebook and talking with the community to get volunteers. Commissioner Vercammen agreed and said it would be a great community service project for groups like the Boy & Girl Scouts.

Motion by Commissioner Hendrick, seconded by Commissioner Vercammen, to move forward with the parklet relocation and request for additional costs. **Roll Call Vote.** Ayes: Vandenbossche, Bryson, Hendrick, Kellehan, Klaassen, Merchant, Vercammen. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

#### Ordinance 2019-011 – Garbage and Refuse Service Hours – 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading/Approval

Motion by Commissioner Hendrick, seconded by Commissioner Kellehan, to approve Ordinance 2019-011 Garbage and Refuse Service Hours. **Roll Call Vote.** Ayes: Vandenbossche, Bryson, Hendrick, Kellehan, Klaassen, Merchant, Vercammen. Nays: None. Motion Carried.



### Employee Wage Survey

City Manager Leven provided recommended hourly pay increases for the City Clerk and Office Clerk, as discussed at the October 17, 2019 meeting. She stated that the recommended hourly pay was within the hourly rate range of the Non-Contractual Employee Classification Wage/Reimbursement table.

Motion by Commissioner Vercammen, seconded by Commissioner Bryson, to follow the City Manager's recommendation to increase the City Clerk's hourly pay to \$28.00 and the Office Clerk's hourly pay to \$16.00. **Roll Call Vote.** Ayes: Vandenbossche, Bryson, Kellehan, Merchant, Vercammen. Nays: Hendrick, Klaassen. Motion Carried.

### Recreational Marijuana Update

City Attorney Davis provided the Board with a copy of the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Marijuana Regulatory Agency Adult-Use Marijuana Establishments Emergency Rules (Filed with the Secretary of State July 3, 2019).

He recommended that the Board direct the Planning Commission to chart required setbacks provided by the State on a map of Marine City to determine where in the community facilities could be located. He suggested that the Planning Commission then report back to the City Commission with their findings.

Motion by Commissioner Bryson, seconded by Commissioner Merchant, to have the City Attorney work with City Manager to develop language to submit to the Planning Commission. All Ayes. Motion Carried.

### Street Paving Project

City Manager Leven advised that the contractor for the paving of Ward and Market Streets started doing the milling on Market Street and found there was insufficient amounts of asphalt on the street, despite preliminary spot checks showing three inches of pavement. City Manager Leven asked for Board approval for an extra \$18,000 to bring in more of the paving material and pay for the additional labor. She warned that the consequences of not adding the additional asphalt would result in the road not lasting as long.

Motion by Mayor Vandenbossche, seconded by Commissioner Kellehan, to authorize the additional paving material for Market Street, not to exceed \$18,000. **Call Vote.** Ayes: Vandenbossche, Bryson, Hendrick, Kellehan, Klaassen, Merchant, Vercammen. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

### Finance Director/Treasurer – Appointment

### Water Plan SCADA Upgrade

Motion by Commissioner Hendrick, seconded by Commissioner Merchant, to waive competitive bidding for the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) Program software upgrade. **Roll Call Vote.** Ayes: Vandenbossche, Bryson, Hendrick, Kellehan, Klaassen, Merchant, Vercammen. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hendrick, seconded by Commissioner Kellehan, to approve the bid from Kerr Pump for the SCADA Program software upgrade, not to exceed \$35,000. **Roll Call Vote.** Ayes: Vandenbossche, Bryson, Hendrick, Kellehan, Klaassen, Merchant, Vercammen. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

### West Boulevard Paving Update

DPW Superintendent Itrich provided an update for 220 West Boulevard and said he found that the drainage issues were a result of the driveway approach being 2.5 inches higher than it should be therefore creating a puddle on the West side of the driveway. He said the only solution to the problem would be to replace the driveway approach and bring it back down to grade and then cut out the section of road and repave to grade.

No action taken by the Board.

### Lighting – Peche Isle Range Rear Light

Chamber of Commerce President, Laura Scaccia, advised the Board that John Brenner of Brenner Electric, had graciously offered to add a waterproof outdoor color-changing LED light to the Peche Isle Range Rear Light so that it may be lit in a festive color for holidays and special events. She asked for Board approval to allow Mr. Brenner to work with DPW Superintendent Itrich on the installation of the light.

Motion by Commissioner Hendrick, seconded by Commissioner Merchant, to move forward with the lighting of the Peche Isle Range Rear Light. All Ayes. Motion Carried.

Commissioner Merchant thanked Todd May for his support and hard work on Merrytime Christmas, and announced the Mike Miller Merrytime 5K Run/Walk that is sponsored by the Marine City Rotary. Both events take place on December 7<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioner Klaassen spoke about the SCC Metropolitan Planning Commission training that he attended which focused on flooding and drainage systems. He said that high water is expected for 2020.

Commissioner Kellehan thanked Paul Merchant for opening up Bower Rose and hosting trunk or treat on Halloween night. She thanked Todd May and his staff for working hard to take this year's Merrytime Christmas to another level. She welcomed Megan Pearce to the City in her new position as Finance Director/Treasurer.

Commissioner Hendrick wished the Marine City Football team good luck in their game against Almont and said it was great to see the whole community come out to support them.

Mayor Vandenbossche congratulated Coach Glodich on his last Mariner football game.

## **Site Plan Review – 1300 Degurse – Zimmerman Development**

Applicant Craig Zimmerman stated that the building will be a private garage to store his hobbies, such as vehicles and boats.

Building Official Wilburn referred the Board to the Site Plan Review completed by Wade Trim who noted several concerns. The concerns were addressed by the Board with the outcome as follows:

### **Item #1 – Trash Receptacle Pad**

The applicant stated that since this was not a commercial building he would handle the trash inside and would not require an outdoor trash receptacle pad.

### **Item #2 – Proposed Signs**

The applicant stated that since this is to be a private building, no signs would be used.

### **Items #3, 4, 5 – Landscaping**

The applicant stated that he would comply with items #3-5 which addressed landscaping requirements. The Board said they would waive the landscaping certificate so long as the landscaping was compliant with the ordinance.

### **Item #6 – Off-Street Loading Spaces**

Architect Larry Nichols stated that due to a clerical error, the loading space was actually 10' x 50' which complied with the ordinance.

### **Item #7 – Off-Street Parking**

To address off-street parking, the Board suggested removing 2-3 parking spots in front of the building so that they wouldn't encroach upon the front yard setback. It was suggested that the applicant could add more parking spaces to the rear of the building, if necessary.

### **Item #8 – Office Portion Have Brick Facade**

After discussion, it was determined by the Board that since it was a private garage with no designated office space, the brick façade requirement should not apply.



**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-012****CITY OF MARINE CITY****COUNTY OF ST. CLAIR, MICHIGAN**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARINE CITY, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, MICHIGAN TO AMEND LAND USAGE TITLE XV, CHAPTER 158 "BUILDING REGULATIONS; CONSTRUCTION" BY ADDING NEW SECTIONS 158.006 THROUGH 158.014 RELATED TO THE CREATION OF A CONSTRUCTION BOARD OF APPEALS.**

**THE CITY OF MARINE CITY ORDAINS:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 158.006 THROUGH 158.114 (CONSTRUCTION BOARD OF APPEALS).**

Title XV, Chapter 158 "BUILDING REGULATIONS; CONSTRUCTION", Sections 158.006 through 158.114 are hereby added to read as follows:

**CONSTRUCTION BOARD OF APPEALS**

**SECTION 158.006. CREATED AND ESTABLISHED.**

Pursuant to the provisions of the State Construction Code, Public Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the city hereby creates and establishes a construction board of appeals to hear and decide all matters properly brought before such construction board of appeals as provided by such Act.

**SECTION 158.007. MEMBERSHIP; APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.**

The construction board of appeals created and established by this division shall be known as and designated as the "Construction Board of Appeals of the City of Marine City." The construction board of appeals shall consist of five members, who shall be appointed by the City Commission. Members of the board shall be appointed to serve in such capacity for two-year terms, and such members shall be qualified by experience or training to perform the duties of members of the



board. Members of the board may serve on the construction board of appeals of more than one governmental subdivision as provided by Public Act No. 230 of 1972.

**SECTION 158.008. OFFICERS; MEETINGS; RULES OF PROCEDURE; QUORUM AND VOTING; RECORDS; WITNESSES.**

(A) Election of chairperson and vice-chairperson. The construction board of appeals shall elect from its membership a chairperson and a vice-chairperson who shall serve in such capacities for the term as fixed and established by the board. The chairperson shall preside over the board and shall chair the meetings of the board. The chairperson shall have the right to vote on all matters coming before the board unless precluded by law. The vice-chairperson shall, in the absence of or disability of the chairperson, perform the duties and functions of the chairperson.

(B) Public meetings. The business which the construction board of appeals may perform shall be conducted at a public meeting of the board and shall be held in compliance with the open meetings act, Public Act No. 267 of 1976. Public notice of the time, date and place of all meetings of the board shall be given in the manner required by such act.

(C) Rules of procedure. The construction board of appeals shall adopt and promulgate rules of procedure to govern and control its business and affairs and all matters coming before it. The board shall also create and approve all necessary forms to be used by persons desiring to formally bring matters before the board.

(D) Scheduling and holding of meetings. Meetings of the construction board of appeals shall be held at the call of the chairperson and at such other times as the board shall determine to be necessary and proper to carry out the functions and duties of the board.

(E) Quorum and voting requirements. Three members of the construction board of appeals shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at a meeting of the board. No motion, resolution or other formal decision shall be adopted, passed or taken except by the affirmative vote of at least three members of the board.



(F) Records. The construction board of appeals shall keep and maintain minutes of its meetings and proceedings, which such minutes shall indicate and describe the nature of all matters coming before and/or decided by the board and the votes and/or actions of all members of the board. Such minutes of the meetings and proceedings of the board shall be filed with the City Clerk. All records of decisions made by the board, properly indexed, and any other writings prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or retained by the board in the performance of an official function shall be considered to be public records and shall be made available to the public in compliance with the freedom of information act, Public Act No. 442 of 1976.

(G) Witnesses. The chairperson of the construction board of appeals or, in his absence, the vice-chairperson may compel the attendance of witnesses at the meetings and proceedings of the board and may administer oaths to any such witnesses.

#### **SECTION 158.009. APPEALS BEFORE BOARD.**

If an enforcing agency of the city, as the term "enforcing agency" is used and defined in section 2 of Public Act No. 230 of 1972, refuses to grant an application for a building permit or if the enforcing agency makes any other decision pursuant to or related to such act or the single state construction code, an interested person or the person's authorized agent may appeal in writing to the construction board of appeals. The construction board of appeals shall hear the appeal and render and file its decision with a statement of reasons for the decision with the enforcing agency from which the appeal was taken not more than 30 days after submission of the appeal. Failure by the construction board of appeals to hear an appeal and file a decision within the time limit specified in this section shall be considered a denial of the appeal for purposes of authorizing the institution of an appeal to the state construction code commission as provided under Public Act No. 230 of 1972. A copy of the decision of the construction board of appeals and a copy of the statement of the reasons for the decision shall be delivered or mailed, before filing, to the party taking the appeal.



#### **SECTION 158.010. GRANTING OF VARIANCES**

(A) Requirements. After a public hearing, the construction board of appeals may grant a specific variance to a substantive requirement of the single state construction code if the literal application of the substantive requirement would result in an exceptional, practical difficulty to the applicant and if both of the following requirements are satisfied:

(1) The performance of the particular item or part of the building or structure with respect to which the variance is granted shall be adequate for its intended use and shall not substantially deviate from performance required by the single state construction code of that particular item or part for the health, safety and welfare of the people of the state.

(2) The specific condition justifying the variance shall be neither so general nor recurrent in nature as to make an amendment of the single state construction code with respect to the condition reasonably practical or desirable.

(B) Variances granted with conditions. The construction board of appeals may attach in writing any condition in connection with the granting of a variance that in its judgment is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the people of the state. The breach of a condition shall automatically invalidate the variance and any permit, license and certificate granted on the basis of it. In no case shall more than a minimum variance from the single state construction code be granted than is necessary to alleviate the exceptional, practical difficulty.

#### **SECTION 158.011. APPEALS OF DECISIONS.**

An interested person or the interested person's authorized agent may appeal a decision of the construction board of appeals to the state construction code commission within ten business days after filing of the decision with the enforcement agency or, in case of an appeal because of failure of the construction board of appeals to act within the prescribed time, at any time before filing of the decision, as provided by Public Act No. 230 of 1972.



#### **SECTION 158.012. PUBLIC HEARINGS.**

When an appeal of an action or decision by the enforcing agency or a request for a variance to a specific requirement of the single state construction code has been filed with the construction board of appeals in the proper manner on the required form as prescribed by the construction board of appeals, such matter shall then be scheduled for a public hearing thereon by the board within a reasonable period of time. Notices of such public hearing indicating the time, place and subject matter of the public hearing shall be served personally or by mail at least seven days prior to the date of such public hearing upon the applicant or appellant, upon the enforcing agency of the city, and upon the owners of property within 300 feet of the subject property, as disclosed by the most recent tax assessment rolls. Any interested party may appear at such public hearing in person or by a duly authorized agent or by attorney.

#### **SECTION 158.013. APPLICATION FEES AND APPEAL FEES.**

Pursuant to the provisions of section 22 of Public Act No. 230 of 1972, the City Commission shall establish by resolution a reasonable fee to be charged to and paid by all applicants and appellants filing an appeal or a request for a variance before the construction board of appeals. The enforcing agency of the city shall collect all such fees established under this section pursuant to the provisions of Public Act No. 230 of 1972.

#### **SECTION 158.014. EFFECT OF APPEALS.**

An appeal to the construction board of appeals or to the state construction code commission pursuant to Public Act No. 230 of 1972 or to a court of competent jurisdiction pursuant to Public Act No. 306 of 1969 does not stay a stop construction order issued by an enforcing agency of the city or prevent an enforcing agency of the city from seeking an order in a court of competent jurisdiction enjoining the violation of a stop construction order. In other cases, an appeal to the construction board of appeals or to the state construction code commission pursuant to Public Act No. 230 of 1972 or to a court of competent jurisdiction pursuant to Public Act No. 306 of 1969



shall act as a stay upon an order, determination, decision or action appealed from, unless the enforcing agency of the city establishes that immediate enforcement of the order, determination, decision or action is necessary to avoid substantial peril to life or property.

## **SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.**

If any part, section, subsection, sentence, phrase, or clause is determined to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is hereby provided that the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARINE CITY, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, MICHIGAN TO AMEND BUSINESS REGULATIONS TITLE XI, CHAPTER 116 "PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS" BY AMENDING SECTIONS 116.21, 116.22 AND 116.23 RELATED TO LICENSE PROVISIONS.**

**THE CITY OF MARINE CITY ORDAINS:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 116.21 (EXEMPTIONS).**

Title XI, Chapter 116 "PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS", Section 116.21 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 116.21. EXEMPTIONS.**

The following shall be exempt from the licensing requirements of this subchapter but shall be subject to the other provisions hereof:

- (A) Farmers and gardeners selling only the products of their own raising or processing;
- (B) Any political group seeking funds or memberships or contacting members or electors;
- (C) Such persons as are exempt by state or federal law to the extent of the exemption; and
- (D) Persons engaged in delivering newspapers.

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 116.22 (APPLICATION).**

Title XI, Chapter 116 "PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS", Section 116.22 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 116.22. APPLICATION.**

(A) The City Clerk shall cause to be prepared an application form to contain all information he or she shall deem relevant to the issuance of a license under this chapter. All applicants desiring to obtain a license under this chapter shall complete said application and return same



to the City Clerk not later than 14 working days before the first date upon which the licensed activity is to commence.

(B) The city shall have the right to assign the administration of the application process as well as collection of the appropriate fees to a responsible third party in the case of large scale special events. The responsible third party shall provide to the city, the original application form for each transient merchant, required support documentation such as insurance and permits, applicable transient merchant permit fee and a comprehensive list of all special event transient merchants a minimum of five working days prior to the special event. Upon final review by the City Clerk and Chief of Police, a blanket permit shall be issued covering the transient merchants in compliance with applicable sections of the city Code.

### **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 116.23 (FEE).**

Title XI, Chapter 116 "PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS", Section 116.23 is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### **SECTION 116.23. FEE.**

The license fee required under this subchapter shall be established by resolution of the City Commission and may be amended from time to time. Such resolution may stipulate that a license fee is not required for church, charitable or labor organizations, education or fraternal societies, and other similar non-profit organizations.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARINE CITY, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, MICHIGAN TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC CODE TITLE VII, CHAPTER 70 "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES" BY ADDING NEW SECTIONS 70.100 THROUGH 70.104 RELATED TO GOLF CARTS AND OFF-ROAD VEHICLES.**

**THE CITY OF MARINE CITY ORDAINS:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 70.100 THROUGH 70.104 (GOLF CARTS AND OFF-ROAD VEHICLES).**

Title VII, Chapter 70 "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES", Sections 70.100 through 70.104 are hereby added to read as follows:

**GOLF CARTS AND OFF-ROAD VEHICLES**

**SECTION 70.100. PURPOSE.**

These regulations are intended to secure the public peace, health and safety of the residents and property owners of the City of Marine City for the regulation of the use of golf carts and off-road vehicles on public streets within the city and for providing penalties for the violation of these provisions.

**SECTION 70.101. DEFINITIONS.**

For the purpose of this subchapter, the following definition shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

***DRIVER'S LICENSE.*** Driver's license means a license, permit, or temporary license issued under the laws of the State of Michigan pertaining to the licensing of persons to operate motor vehicles.

***GOLF CART.*** Golf cart means a vehicle designed for transportation while playing the game of



golf. For the purposes of this subchapter, off-road vehicles, as defined herein, are not considered golf carts.

**OFF-ROAD VEHICLE ("ORV").** Off-road vehicle ("ORV") means a motor-driven, off-road recreational vehicle capable of cross-country travel without the benefit of a road or trail, on or immediately over land, snow, ice, marsh, swampland, or other natural terrain. ORV includes, but is not limited to, a multi-track or multi-wheel drive vehicle; an all-terrain vehicle ("ATV"); an amphibious machine; a ground-effect air cushion vehicle; or other means of transportation deriving power from a source other than muscle or wind. For the purposes of this subchapter, this definition shall not include a minibike or minicycle as defined and regulated in § 70.015 et seq. of this Code.

**OPERATE.** Operate means to ride in or on, or be in actual physical control of a golf cart or an off-road vehicle.

**OPERATOR.** Operator means a person who operates and/or is in actual physical control of a golf cart or an off-road vehicle.

**STREET.** Street means a road, roadway, street or right-of-way within the City of Marine City street system, but does not include a private road. The terms road, roadway, street and right-of-way are interchangeable.

**SUNSET AND SUNRISE.** Sunset and sunrise as determined by the National Weather Service on any given day.

## **SECTION 70.102.     OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS ON CITY STREETS.**

A person may operate a golf cart on city streets, subject to the following restrictions:

- (A) A person shall not operate a golf cart on any street unless he or she is at least 16 years old and is licensed to operate a motor vehicle.
- (B) The operator of a golf cart shall comply with the signal requirements of MCL Section 257.648, as amended, that apply to the operation of a vehicle.



(C) All golf carts are required to have a red reflector on the rear of the golf cart that shall be visible from distances up to 500 feet when in front of lawful low beams of headlamps on a motor vehicle.

(D) The operator of a golf cart shall obey by all sections pertaining to traffic in the Michigan Vehicle Code and the Uniform Traffic Code.

(E) A person operating a golf cart upon a street shall ride as near to the right side of the street as practicable, exercising due care when passing a standing vehicle or one proceeding in the same direction.

(F) A person shall not operate a golf cart on a state trunk line highway except to cross that state trunk line highway.

(G) Where a usable and designated path for golf carts is provided adjacent to a road or street, a person operating a golf cart shall be required to use that path. A golf cart shall not be operated on a sidewalk constructed for the use of pedestrians.

(H) A person operating a golf cart shall not pass between lines of traffic, but may pass on the left of traffic moving in his or her direction in the case of a two-way street, or on the left or right of traffic, in an unoccupied lane, in the case of a one-way street.

(I) A golf cart shall be operated at a speed not to exceed 15 miles per hour and shall not be operated on a street with a speed limit of more than 25 miles per hour except to cross that street.

(J) A golf cart shall not be operated on the streets of the city from the time period beginning one-half hour before sunset and ending one-half hour after sunrise.

(K) An operator or a passenger in a golf cart is not required to wear a crash helmet.

(L) A golf cart shall not be used to carry more persons at one time than the number for which it is designed.

(M) A golf cart operated on a street of the city is not required to be registered under the Michigan Vehicle Code for purposes of section 3101 of the Insurance Code of 1956, 1956 PA



218, MCL Section 500.3101, as amended.

(N) A golf cart shall not be operated during weather events with snow and/or ice on the ground.

(O) Golf carts shall not be operated on a road or street in a negligent manner, endangering any person or property, or obstructing, or impeding the lawful course of travel of any motor vehicle or the lawful use by any pedestrian of public streets, sidewalks, paths, trails, walkways or parks.

(P) The parking, stopping, and standing regulations provided in the city Code, which may be adopted by reference therein, shall also apply to golf carts operated in the city, as if they are motor vehicles under those provisions.

(Q) This section does not apply to a police officer, city officials, employees, contractors or volunteers operating a golf cart in the performance of city duties.

**SECTION 70.103. OPERATION OF OFF-ROAD VEHICLES ON CITY STREETS.**

Except as set forth herein or otherwise provided by law, a person may operate an ORV on city streets, subject to the following restrictions:

(A) A person operating an ORV on a street shall ride as near to the right side of the street as practicable, exercising due care when passing a standing vehicle or one proceeding in the same direction.

(B) A person shall not operate an ORV on a state trunk line highway except to cross that state trunk line highway.

(C) A person shall not operate an ORV on a street with a speed limit of more than 25 miles per hour except to cross that street.

(D) A person shall operate an ORV at a speed of no more than 25 miles per hour, or a lower ORV posted speed limit;

(E) A person shall not operate an ORV on any street unless he or she is at least 16 years



old and is licensed to operate a motor vehicle.

(F) A person shall operate an ORV with the flow of traffic;

(G) A person shall operate an ORV in a manner that does not interfere with traffic;

(H) A person shall operate an ORV in single file except when overtaking and passing another ORV;

(I) A person shall operate an ORV while displaying a working, visible lighted headlight and lighted taillight at all hours;

(J) The operator and each passenger of the ORV shall wear a crash helmet and protective eyewear approved by the United States Department of Transportation, unless the ORV is equipped with a roof that meets or exceeds standards for a crash helmet and the operator and each passenger are wearing a properly adjusted and fastened seat belt;

(K) An ORV shall be operated with a throttle so designed that when the pressure used to advance the throttle is removed, the engine speed will immediately and automatically idle;

(L) An ORV shall be equipped with a spark-arrester type, United States Forest Service-approved muffler in good working order and in constant operation; and

(M) An ORV shall be operated consistent with noise and emission standards defined by law.

#### **SECTION 70.104. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.**

(A) A person who violates any of the provisions of this subchapter shall be responsible for a municipal civil infraction, and shall be subject to the penalty provisions of § 10.99 of the Code.

#### **SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.**

This Ordinance and each of the various parts, sections, subsections, sentences, phrases, and clauses hereof are declared to be severable. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, phrase, or clause is determined to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction,

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARINE CITY, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, MICHIGAN TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC CODE TITLE VII, CHAPTER 70 "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES" BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 70.007 RELATED TO DISTRACTED DRIVING.**

**THE CITY OF MARINE CITY ORDAINS:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO ADD NEW SECTION 70.007 (DISTRACTED DRIVING).**

Title VII, Chapter 70 "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES", Section 70.007 is hereby added to read as follows:

**SECTION 70.007. DISTRACTED DRIVING.**

(A) *Definition. "Distracted driving" means the following:*

(1) The physical manipulation of any 2-way wireless electronic communication device used for dialing numbers; or scrolling; or typing or entering multiple letters, numbers, symbols, or other text; or the sending, receiving, and reading of any non-voice data in the device while the motor vehicle is in motion on any highway or street or place open to the general public within the City of Marine City. As used in this subsection, a wireless 2-way communication device does not include a global positioning or navigation system that is affixed to the motor vehicle.

(2) The physical manipulation or handling of any wireless entertainment or electronic communication device for the purpose of speaking into, or listening to voice data, while the motor vehicle is in motion on any highway or street or place open to the general public within the City of Marine City.

(3) Any action by the driver of a motor vehicle that diverts his or her attention resulting in the failure to use due care and caution in the safe operation of a motor vehicle while the vehicle is in motion on any highway or street or place open to the general public within the City of



Marine City. Such action can include but is not limited to: eating, reading, writing, performing personal hygiene/ grooming, physical interaction with pets, passengers, or unsecured cargo, any of which is done in a manner that prohibits the driver from maintaining direct physical control of the motor vehicle steering mechanism with at least one hand that is free of all other objects and used entirely to form a controlled grip on the steering mechanism.

(B) *Distracted Driving; Violation as Civil Infraction.*

(1) A person shall not engage in distracted driving within the City of Marine City.

(2) A person who violates this section shall be responsible for a municipal civil infraction, and shall be subject to the penalty provisions of § 10.99 of the code.

(3) Exceptions. This section does not apply to a person who is using an electronic communication device to do one or more of the following:

(a) Report a traffic accident, medical emergency or serious road hazard.

(b) Report a situation in which the person believes his or her personal safety is in jeopardy.

(c) Report or avert the perpetration or potential perpetration of a criminal act against the individual or another person.

(d) Carry out official duties as a police officer, law enforcement official, member of a paid or volunteer fire department, or operator of an emergency vehicle.

**SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.**

This Ordinance and each of the various parts, sections, subsections, sentences, phrases, and clauses hereof are declared to be severable. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, phrase, or clause is determined to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is hereby provided that the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.



**SECTION 3. REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.**

Any and all Ordinances of the City of Marine City or any parts or provisions thereof, to the extent that they are contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of the within Ordinance, are hereby expressly repealed.

## CITY OF MARINE CITY

## COUNTY OF ST. CLAIR, MICHIGAN

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARINE CITY, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, MICHIGAN TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC CODE TITLE VII, CHAPTER 70 "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES" BY AMENDING SECTION 70.999 RELATED TO PENALTIES.**

**THE CITY OF MARINE CITY ORDAINS:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 70.999 (PENALTY).**

Title VII, Chapter 70 "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES", Section 70.999 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 70.999. PENALTY.**

(A) The penalties provided by the Michigan Vehicle Code are adopted by reference. The city may not enforce any provision of the Michigan Vehicle Code for which the maximum period of imprisonment is greater than 93 days, provided, however, that a violation of MCL 257.625(1)(C) is punishable by one or more of the following: community service of not more than 360 hours, imprisonment for not more than one hundred eighty (180) days, and a fine of not less than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars or more than seven hundred (\$700.00) dollars.

(B) Any violation of § 70.006, or any part thereof, shall be deemed a civil infraction and is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100. Each day that a violation exists or continues to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

(C) Any individual, corporation or other legal entity found to have violated any of the provisions §§ 70.075et seq. shall be responsible for a civil infraction with a fine not to exceed \$500.

**SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.**

This Ordinance and each of the various parts, sections, subsections, sentences, phrases, and clauses hereof are declared to be severable. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, phrase, or clause is determined to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction,
