UNFINISHED BUSINESS

2019-2020 Budget

Treasurer/Finance Director McDonald distributed the following as a follow-up to the April 23, 2019 Budget Workshop meeting:

- Updated Cemetery Fund Budget with a columbaria included; General Fund contributed an additional \$5,000 to offset expense
- Updated Local Street Fund Routine Maintenance Budget with verbiage corrected
- Updated Election Budget with the addition of a third election

Three aging Police Department and DPW vehicles were discussed and it was decided that one patrol vehicle would be sold. In addition, either the current Inspection/Code Enforcement vehicle or DPW vehicle would be sold. DPW Superintendent Itrich to evaluate the two vehicles to determine which to keep.

Water/Sewer Fund

Treasurer/Finance Director McDonald recommended a cost of living increase of 1.50%. The proposed increase would cost a family of four approximately \$9.90 a quarter and \$39.00 annually. She also reported that all capital improvement projects in Water/Sewer were being funded using restricted Ready to Serve fees and restricted Water Monitoring fees.

Motion by Commissioner Hendrick, seconded by Commissioner Kellehan, to proceed with the recommended 2019/2020 Budget and give Treasurer/Finance Director McDonald direction to move forward and present the Budget at the May 16, 2019 Public Hearing.
