I will cooperate with the State Mechanical Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections.

Item #2, Residential Heating System: This item is used for the installation of a heating system in a new residential structure. Items #10 Gas Piping and #18 Duct SHOULD NOT BE charged. Replacement systems should be itemized.

Items #14 and #15, Tanks: A homeowner must own tank to install. If homeowner does not own tank, a licensed mechanical contractor must install tank.

General: Mechanical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Mechanical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the iob location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTES AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE **REFUNDED. THE CHARGE TO RE-OPEN A CLOSED PERMIT IS \$75.00**
