Notice is hereby given that, until further notice, the following guidelines will be followed at Woodlawn Cemetery to limit the spread of COVID-19 and to remain in compliance with Governor Whitmer's Executive Order 2020-21:

- We will allow for procession into the Cemetery
- The procession will be stopped once all vehicles have entered the gates and are off the main road
- At this point, the funeral coach, funeral director and casket or urn will continue to the grave site for direct internment while the rest of the procession remains behind
- We ask that a limit of 2 persons be designated by the family to witness the internment
- Following the internment, our staff will remove themselves from the burial site and then the procession may approach
- In the event we have two funerals at the same time, we will use 11:00 am and 2:00 pm time slots
- There will be no chapel service at this time
- It is acceptable for 1 tent with no sides to be set up with up to 4 chairs,
 spaced apart
